^{*} The dollar amounts in the Ongoing Funding Total column come from adding the amounts listed in the Project Funding Amount column. I.E. \$1,000,000 (Police Homeland Defense Preparedness Initiatives) is added to \$1,500,000 (Fire-Rescue Homeland Defense Preparedness Initiatives), to equal \$2,500,000. Then \$25,000 (Miami Circle Greenway) is added to equal \$2,525,000...and so on. All bond funding is then tallied for the year.
