Early Voting for the March 15, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary Election and City of Miami Referendum Special Election has been scheduled for the designated sites, dates, and times referenced below. City of Miami registered voters may choose to vote at any of the Early Voting sites on the dates and times in which they are open.

Stephen P. Clark Government Center , 111 NW 1 st Street, Miami, FL 33128 (Supervisor of Elections Branch Office Located in the Lobby)

When voting at any voting location, whether at an Early Voting site or on Election Day, be sure to bring a current and valid identification that contains your name, photograph and signature. While it is not required that you bring your voter information card to the polling place, it will expedite your check-in process.

To be eligible to vote in the March 15, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary Election and City of Miami Referendum Special Election, you must be registered to vote with the Miami-Dade County Elections Department by February 16, 2016. Registered voters who choose to vote on Election Day **must** vote at their assigned polling place.
