City of Miami registered voters may choose to vote at any of the Early Voting sites on the dates and times in which they are open.

THE HISTORIC GARAGE LOCATED ON THE SAME PROPERTY AS THE OLD MUSEUM OF SCIENCE WILL BE USED AS A REPLACEMENT SITE (SEE BELOW\*).**
