REQUIREMENTS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

To be eligible to vote for members of the OAB/OCOB, the elector must be 18 years of age or older;
AND

1. Reside in the Overtown Area; **OR**
2. Own property or operate a business in the Overtown Area; **OR**
3. Be an employee or board member of a community development corporation or community based organization located in and providing services to the Overtown Area, **OR**
4. Operate or be an employee of a business in the Overtown Area.
