Recommendation

Based on the findings below, the Department of Procurement (Procurement) hereby recommends award of Contract No. RFQ 16-17-057 to Alleguez Architecture, Inc.; Carty Architecture, LLC; R.E. Chisholm Architects, Inc.; Diaz, Carreño, Scotti & Partners; Ferguson Glasgow Schsuter Soto, Inc.; Gurri Matute, P.A.; Leo A. Daly; M.C. Harry & Associates, Inc.; Rodriguez and Quiroga Architects Chartered; and Wolfberg Alvarez & Partners (the Consultants), for Miscellaneous Architectural Services Projects (the Contract).

The Contract is necessary to provide the City of Miami with comprehensive professional architectural services for the City of Miami (City) including, but not limited to, planning and design services, construction documents, construction administration, and various reports for the successful, timely, and economical completion of architectural design related projects. The Services shall support new construction, remodeling/renovation, and building assessment of community centers, fire stations, marinas, aquatic facilities, parks facilities, and public safety facilities for governmental, institutional, and/or recreational projects. The aforementioned services must comply with all applicable laws, building and environmental regulations, including the Florida Building Code and the City of Miami, Florida, Code of Ordinances, and as set forth in the attached Agreements, and further enumerated in the resulting Work Orders. Consultants may be required to perform all or some of the services described in the attached Agreements, depending on the needs of the City for the Project.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact to the City of Miami (City) as a result of the Work included under each of these contracts will not exceed your delegated authority of \$500,000. The unloaded rates proposed by the Consultants varied between \$100.00 for Principals and \$16.00 for the lowest required classification. The final rates proposed by the City, and accepted by the Consultants, ranged from \$62.00 to \$13.00 for the proposed classifications, resulting in considerable savings for our taxpayers.

Background

On September 29, 2017, the Department of Procurement ("Procurement") issued Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") No. 16-17-057 under full and open competition, to obtain proposals from qualified and experienced professional consulting firms to procure a pool of architectural consultants, for the Office of Capital Improvements ("OCI"), in accordance with Florida Statute, Section 287.055, the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA). On November 1, 2017, 14 proposals were received in response to this solicitation. Subsequently, the proposals were reviewed by Procurement staff, and 12 of them were deemed responsive and responsible in

accordance with the minimum submission requirements of the RFQ. Responses from LIVS Associates and Heery International, Inc. were found to be non-responsive due to the lack of response to Notices to Cure sent to the firms on November 6, 2017 and November 22, 2017, respectively. Following evaluations of the proposals, the Evaluation Committee recommended the 10 top-ranked responsive and responsible Proposers, for negotiations. Subsequently, a Negotiations Team (Team) met on December 19, 2017, to review the scope of services and the firm's price proposal; discussions were completed, and rates approved by OCI on March 16, 2018.

Background

On September 29, 2017, the Department of Procurement ("Procurement") issued Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") No. 16-17-057 for the provision of Architectural Services for Miscellaneous Projects ("Services"), to procure a pool of architectural consultants for the Office of Capital Improvements ("OCI"). On November 1, 2017, fourteen (14) proposals were received in response to this solicitation. Subsequently, the proposals were reviewed by Procurement staff, upon which twelve (12) proposals were deemed responsive and responsible in accordance with the minimum requirements of the RFQ. Two (2) proposals, submitted by LIVS Associates, LLC, and Heery International, Inc., were deemed non-responsive and, therefore, disqualified from the procurement process for failure to meet the minimum requirements of the RFQ.

Summary of Evaluation

On January 17, 2018, the Evaluation Committee ("Committee") met and completed the evaluation of the twelve (12) responsive and responsible proposals following the guidelines stipulated in the solicitation. The proposals were evaluated pursuant to the five (5) evaluation criteria listed below:

Evaluation Criteria	Maximum Points (Per Committee Member)
1. Proposer's Experience and Qualifications	35
2. Proposer's Team Experience	35
3. Experience of Project Manager	10
4. Design Philosophy and Process	10
5. Technical Approach	10

Proposers who agreed to meet the Small Business Enterprise ("SBE") participation requirement by assigning certified SBE Firms with a "Local Office," as defined in the City of Miami (City) Procurement Code, Section 18-73, would be granted five (5) Bonus Points, in accordance with the RFQ and the City Procurement Code, Section 18-87, as amended. Six (6) Proposers, Gurri Matute, P.A., Ferguson Glasgow Schuster Soto, Inc., M.C. Harry and Associates, Inc., MOBIO Architecture, Inc., TSAO Design Group, Incorporated, and Leo A. Daly Company, met the SBE participation requirement using the "Local Office" criteria, and were granted five (5) Bonus Points.



The composite and individual Committee member score sheets are attached as supporting documentation. As indicated in the table above, the top ten (10) scores ranged above eighty percent (80%) of the total possible points. Therefore, the Committee determined that the top ten (10) firms have the experience, qualifications, and expertise required to provide the Services. The Committee decided not to hold oral presentations, as the proposals did not require further clarification.


Recommendation

The Committee hereby requests authorization for Procurement, in collaboration with OCI, to commence negotiations with the top ten (10) firms, for the provision of Architectural Services for Miscellaneous Projects based on the immediate and projected needs of the City. The top ten (10) firms are qualified according to the specifications set forth in the RFQ and the technical evaluation completed by the Committee. The Committee further recommends that Procurement be authorized to cease negotiations after the Professional Services Agreements are successfully negotiated and subsequently awarded, in accordance with Section 18-87 of the City of Miami Code.





