MARY BRICKELL VILLAGE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS (PUMP STATION)

Bids Due: Thursday, July 30, 2015 @ 2:00 P.M.

Scope of Work: The work consists of furnishing all materials, labor and equipment necessary for a drainage stormwater pump station system installation (wells, pumps, pipes, structures) and roadway reconstruction and/or milling & resurfacing, new sidewalks, curb and gutter, swale restoration, striping, signs, landscaping, and ADA compliant ramps necessary for the restoration of the surrounding area.

Capital Improvements and Transportation Program (CITP) has scheduled a **NON-MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE to be held on the following date, time and location:**

Minimum Requirements: Prospective Bidders must have: **i)** a current Certified General Contractor license issued by the State of Florida, **or** a Miami-Dade County Certificate of Competency as a General Engineering Contractor; **and, in addition, ii)** a State of Florida Water Well Contractor license held by the Bidder or its subcontractor who will be responsible for completing the Well work. Prospective Bidders must have a minimum of five (5) years of experience under its current business name in the construction, installation, repair and replacement of stormwater pump stations and drainage system projects involving public right-of-way, and maintenance of vehicular traffic, supported by references for five (5) projects completed within the past five (5) years. Submitted reference projects must demonstrate that the Bidder: **i)** was the Prime Contractor for the referenced project; **and ii)** self-performed at least thirty percent (30%) of the physical construction work for the referenced project. At least two (2) of the referenced projects must have involved the construction and/or installation of a stormwater pump station. Contractor must self-perform at least thirty percent (30%) of the physical construction work for the Project.
