The City of Miami Department of Community and Economic Development ("DCED") is announcing the availability of seats to serve as a voting member to the Housing and Commercial Loan Committee ("HCLC").

The HCLC's purpose is to approve and/or disapprove certain housing and commercial loans and/or grants to be provided by the City of Miami under Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG"), HOME Investment Partnership Program ("HOME"), Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS ("HOPWA"), State Housing Initiatives Program ("SHIP"), Affordable Housing Trust Fund ("AHTF"), and any other funds administered by the DCED.

The HCLC consists of 13 members and currently there are open seats for individuals with expertise in the areas of:

- (1) A person actively engaged in home building industry in connection with affordable housing (AH);
- (2) A person actively engaged in the banking and mortgage banking industry in connection with AH;
- (3) A person who is a representative of those areas of labor actively engaged in home building with AH;
- (4) A person actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with AH;
- (5) A person actively engaged as a for-profit provider of AH;
- (6) A person actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of AH;
- (7) A person actively engaged as a real estate professional in connection with AH;
- (8) A person who resides within the city limits of the city;
- (9) A person who represents employers within the city;
- (10) A person who represents essential services personnel, as defined in the local housing assistance plan <http://www.miamigov.com/communitydevelopment/Docs/Reports/CityofMiamiLHAP20132015I.pdf>;
- (11) One Chairperson nominated by the mayor and appointed by city commission;
- (12) Two members from city administration nominated by the city manager and appointed by city commission. One of these two members shall actively serve on the city's planning department.
