### Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program Waiting List Opening

#### **Pre-applications will only be accepted via U.S. Mail**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Miami Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED) will open its Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Waiting List in accordance to the regulations outlined by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) and will make pre-applications available on October 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of 2014, at the following locations:

All pre-applications with a postmark from the USPS® (United States Postal Service) on or before October 17, 2014, that also meet all other minimum requirements will be accepted into the lottery. All pre-applications received during this allotted period will be considered as applying at the same time. It does not matter if an application is received on the first or last day. All pre-applications will go through a computerized lottery process and will be assigned a randomly selected ranking number of **which only 100 will be selected for the waiting list.** Once the waiting list has been defined, we will apply a local preference to the following groups (in no particular order):

**\*Elderly:** A family whose head of household, spouse, or sole member is 62 years of age or older.

**\*Disabled:** A family with at least one disabled family member.

As per federal guidelines, 75% of persons admitted annually to the program will be families with extremely low income.

Applicants who make false statements in order to qualify for a preference will be removed from the waiting list. **At this time, there are no available vouchers and typically approximately 5 persons are called from our waiting list each year.**

ONLY ONE APPLICATION PER HOUSEHOLD WILL BE PERMITTED. Families who submit more than one application will be disqualified. Please do not call the DCED for updates on the waiting list process; starting December 1<sup>st</sup> you can check if your application made the waiting list by visiting our website at [www.miamigov.com/communitydevelopment/pages/housing/S8VoucherWL.asp](http://www.miamigov.com/communitydevelopment/pages/housing/S8VoucherWL.asp). Only the 100 applicants/families randomly selected for the waiting list will be advised in writing (U.S. mail) by December 15, 2014.
