The City of Miami's Department of Community & Economic Development invites all interested public service agencies, AIDS service providers, non-profit agencies and/or for-profit entities, to attend the Pre-Proposal Workshops to be held this September for assistance with the Request for Proposal (RFP) process for those applicants seeking Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and/or Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funds for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 (42nd Year).
