
The following changes, additions, clarifications, and/or deletions amend the above-captioned Invitation to Bid (ITB) and shall become an integral part of the Bid submitted and the Contract to be executed for **Hadley Park Synthetic Turf and Park Improvements, D5 - ITB No.: 17-18-050** (the "Project"). Please note the contents herein and affix same to the documents you have on hand.

All attachments (if any) are available on the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) website and are part of this Addendum.

- A. The "**City of Miami Approved Plans Revised**" attachment has revised Sheet C-5.4. The revised sheet is identified and attached to this Addendum as "**Attachment No. 2 – Revised Sheet C-5.4**".
- B. The "**Specifications**" attachment has replaced pages 5 of 14 and 6 of 14 in the *Specification Section 321823.29-5 Synthetic Field Sport Surfacing*. The pages are attached to this Addendum as "**Attachment No. 3 – Replaced Specifications Pages.**"
- C. **Requests for Information – Since Issuance of ITB No. 17-18-008:**
 - Q1. Is removal of the existing scoreboard part of the base bid or is it part of the alternate for installing a new scoreboard?
 - A1. **Yes, the removal of the old/existing scoreboard is to be included on the base bid. The Contractor is to coordinate with the City of Miami for either the disposal or salvage to be stored within the City limits.**
 - Q2. Where is the proposed contractor staging area located?
 - A2. **The staging area is to be kept within the boundaries of the project site.**
 - Q3. Please provide as built drawings for the existing drainage system that must be cleaned.

- A3.** The Pollution Prevention Plans show structures to be protected and cleaned after construction. These are located in the vicinity of the project site. Contractor is responsible to maintain protection and clean the indicated inlets/structures, plus any downstream pipe and structure interconnected with the system.
- Q4.** Please provide soil boring test results for this site.
- A4.** Refer to the Specifications Book for full geotechnical report.
- Q5.** Sheet C-1.1 states that, "existing underground wiring to be removed and stored conduits to be abandoned." Does this mean that existing conduit must be returned to the owner rather than be disposed of?
- A5.** This means wires shall be pulled, stored and returned to the City. Underground empty conduits to be abandoned.
- Q6.** Will any phasing be required?
- A6.** The project is to be built in one phase.
- Q7.** The existing concession building falls within the limits of the required temporary fencing. Please confirm that the concession building will remain closed during construction.
- A7.** The concession building is to remain closed during construction.
- Q8.** Will the contractor be allowed to use existing water and electricity on site?
- A8.** Refer to the ITB Document, Section 4, Article 9 "Project Site Facilities" for clarification on this question.
- Q9.** Per sheet E-1.1, conduit must be run to room 100 in the concession building, but the concession building floor plan does not have room numbers. Please confirm which room is room 100.
- A9.** These conduits shall be terminated in the room where the IT Cabinet is located. Please refer to detail on Sheet E-2.1.
- Q10.** Can the Bidder/General Contractor utilize the Sub-Contractors athletic turf installation experience to qualify the ITB's past work requirements (i.e. 3 projects whose scope included the construction/renovation of athletic fields...), the Bidder/GC will utilize its own forces for 30% of the work as defined.
- A10.** No. The Bidder must provide "three (3) projects whose scope include the construction/renovation of athletic fields." If a Sub-Contractor is installing the Turf, then another three (3) projects completing synthetic turf athletic fields must also be submitted with the bid.
