LEGION PARK SEAWALL AND BOAT RAMP, D5 B-40510

Scope of Work: The Work consists of, but is not limited to, the reconstruction of boat ramp and parking lot, new seawall, bay-walk, new pier dock, solar lighting, drainage upgrade, new metal picket fence with gate, benches, trash receptacles, and signs. The full scope of the Work is detailed in the Contract Documents.

Minimum Requirements: Prospective Bidders shall, as of the Bid Due Date:

- A.** Have a current **Certified General Contractor (“CGC”)** license from the State of Florida or a Miami-Dade County Certificate of Competency as a **General Engineering Contractor AND** have a minimum of five (5) years’ experience **under its current business name.**
- B.** The General Contractor shall have experience as the Prime Contractor for at least three (3) completed projects of similar scope and complexity within the last five (5) years. The reference projects must consist of the following components: marine demolition, marine construction, marine structural repairs (i.e. spalls, cracks, etc.), pile driving, heavy marine and foundation construction, steel sheet piling installation, marina improvements/repairs, associated dock construction, marina (overwater) utilities, and conducting construction for public projects. The General Contractor must have a proven track record of coordination of the trades required for structural, mechanical, plumbing, and electrical work required for the marina rehabilitation.

Submitted reference projects, utilizing **Form ITB-GCR**, must demonstrate that the General Contractor: i) was the General Contractor for the project; ii) self-performed at least thirty percent (30%) of the physical labor construction work for the project; and iii) at least one (1) of the reference projects must have been performed within the State of Florida.

- C.** The Project Manager assigned to this project shall have experience as the Project Manager for at least three (3) completed projects of similar scope and complexity within the last five (5) years. Utilize **Form ITB-PCR** for the reference projects.
- D.** The Superintendent assigned to this project shall have experience as the Superintendent for at least three (3) completed projects of similar scope and complexity within the last five (5) years. Utilize **Form ITB-SIR** for the reference projects.

The City reserves the right to request additional / supplemental information and/or contact listed persons pertaining to Bidder's experience / minimum requirements.

Failure to submit one (1) original full set may result in the bid being deemed non-responsive. **Any bids received after the time and date specified will be rejected and will not be considered.** The responsibility for submitting a bid before the indicated time and date is solely and strictly that of the Bidder. The City is not responsible for any delay, regardless of the cause.
