TO: ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The following changes, additions, clarifications, and/or deletions amend the above-captioned Invitation to Bid and shall become an integral part of the Bids submitted and the Contract to be executed for **RIVERVIEW STORM SEWER PUMP STATION - EMERGENCY GENERATOR, CO2 FIRE SUPPRESSANT SYSTEM AND MAIN SWITCH DISCONNECT, M-0127C** (the "Project"). Please note the contents herein and affix it to the documents you have on hand.

All attachments (if any) are available on the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) website and are part of this Addendum.

A. The following are revisions to the ITB document.

1. Section 1 – Instructions for Submission, Article 8. Bid Guaranty: The following language is hereby deleted:

~~"Bid Bond Voucher (for Projects totaling less than two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) inclusive of all fees, costs, and expenses)."~~

B. The following are the inquiries received and the corresponding responses:

- Q1.** At the prebid we were told that a Bid Bond and a performance bond were required in order to bid this job, and our bonding company has the following questions regarding the bid bond.

1. What is the Engineers preliminary cost of the project?
2. If an engineers cost is not available what is the city's budget?

A1: Please note, while the ITB document specifies the need for both a Bid Bond (see Article 8. Bid Guaranty, on page 8), and a Performance and Payment Bond (see Article 8. Performance and Payment Bond, on page 20), only the Bid Bond is required with submission of your bid. The Performance and Payment Bond shall be required only from the firm awarded the Project. The City's budget for the Project is \$1,130,000 including hard and soft costs.

Q2. The specs mention a Bid Bond Voucher Program that the City of Miami provides for certain jobs. Which department within the City of Miami handles the Bid Bond Vouchers. Please provide an email or a phone number of whom we need to talk to regarding the program.

A2: Please refer to A.1., above. The Bid Bond Voucher program has been discontinued.
