Recommendation

Based on the findings below, the Procurement Department ("Procurement") hereby recommends approval to award Professional Services Agreements (PSAs) to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. ("Kimley-Horn"), and HNTB Corporation ("HNTB"), pursuant to Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") No. 15-16-028, for the provision of Transportation Program Support Services ("Services") for the Office of Transportation Management. The PSAs shall be awarded in accordance with Florida Statute § 287.055, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, by the authority of the City Manager, pursuant to § 18-87(m) of the City of Miami Procurement Code.

Background

On July 6, 2016, the City of Miami ("the City"), through Procurement, issued RFQ No. 15-16-028 for the Services, under full and open competition. Procurement received two (2) proposals on the closing date, August 8, 2016. Accordingly, on September 21, 2016, the Evaluation Committee ("Committee") met and completed the evaluation of the two (2) responsive and responsible proposals following the guidelines stipulated in the solicitation. The proposals were evaluated pursuant to the five (5) evaluation criteria, and ranked by total awarded points (see enclosed Report of Evaluation Committee).

The City Manager's approval of the Committee's report commenced the negotiations process with both firms. As a result, a PSA was successfully negotiated with each firm.

Agreement Execution

Accordingly, Procurement hereby requests authorization to prepare for execution, two (2) PSAs; Kimley-Horn and HNTB. Your signature below will indicate approval.

Background

The Procurement Department ("Procurement") issued Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") No. 15-16-028 on July 6, 2016, for the provision of Transportation Program Support Services ("Services") for the Capital Improvements and Transportation Program ("CITP"). Procurement received two (2) proposals on the closing date, August 8, 2016. The two (2) proposals were reviewed by Procurement staff to confirm compliance with the submission requirements of the solicitation.

Summary of Evaluation

On September 21, 2016, the Evaluation Committee ("Committee") met and completed the evaluation of the two (2) responsive and responsible proposals, following the guidelines stipulated in the solicitation. The proposals were evaluated pursuant to the five (5) evaluation criteria listed below:

1. Proposer's Experience and Qualifications	25
2. Proposer's Team Experience	25
3. Management Plan	25
4. Experience of Program Coordinator	15

The final scores are as follows:

1. Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.	460
2. HNTB Corporation	456

The Committee decided not to hold oral presentations, as the proposals did not require further clarification. The composite and individual Committee member score sheets are attached as supporting documentation.


Other Information

Recommendation

The Committee hereby requests approval for Procurement, in collaboration with CITP, to commence negotiations with the two (2) firms for the provision of Transportation Program Support Services based on the immediate and projected needs of the City. Both firms are qualified according to the specifications set forth in the RFQ and the technical evaluation completed by the Committee. The Committee further recommends that Procurement be authorized to cease negotiations after all two (2) Professional Services Agreements are successfully negotiated and subsequently awarded.


