Dear Mr. Eubanks,

In a letter from you dated August 28, 2017, you acknowledged the City of Miami's proposal to bifurcate adoption of its EAR-based amendments, with the deadline for adopting the Transportation Element by **November 28, 2017** and the remaining amendments by November 28, 2018.

Due to Hurricane Irma and its associated impacts, the City requires additional time to schedule the final hearing for the adoption of the Transportation Element. Please accept this modification of the time extension for **only the Transportation Element to February 1, 2018.**

The Department of Planning and Zoning remains on schedule for adoption and transmittal of the remaining amendments for no later than November 28, 2018.
