



Below is the schedule of prices for maps and prints sold by this Department.

<u>Size of Print</u>	<u>Price</u>
Size up to and including 24" x 36"	\$3.00
Larger than 24" x 36"	\$5.00
Aerial Photo Prints	\$5.00

1. Sale of maps and prints will be handled by the Central File staff who will price all material sold. Payment will be accepted and an official receipt given by the Survey/Central File Section.
2. The above prices apply to all papers and all sepia-line intermediates in ordinary use by this Department. Special orders for cloth, mylar or other reproduction material not usually stocked by the Department, will be individually priced by the Cost Analysis Section Head.
3. Orders placed by governmental units of Miami-Dade County, State of Florida, etc., will be individually priced by the Cost Analysis Section Head.
4. Orders of more than 10 prints of one tracing will be subject to special pricing by the Cost Analysis Section Head.
5. The practice of giving prints at no charge has been discontinued. This applies to old maps, plans returned by unsuccessful bidders and surplus copies of plans or prints or other drawings, all of which can be sold to the public at the prices shown above.
