**Subject: POLLUTION MONITORING WELL PERMITS**

Processing of an application for a Pollution Monitoring Well in the public right-of-way shall follow the procedure listed below:

1. A brief explanation of the nature and schedule for the work being proposed.
2. Name and business address of the well drilling company.
3. Name and business address of the licensed engineering contractor who will accomplish the right-of-way restoration.

NOTE: A 1 :10 cement/sand mix must be used to fill the well(s) after pollution testing has been completed and the public right-of-way must be restored to the satisfaction of the Department of Public Works.

4. A performance bond as a guarantee against defective work or defective restoration must be provided. A check made payable to "The City of Miami" shall accompany the permit application. The bond amount shall conform to the following schedule:

One to Six Wells	\$ 500.00
Seven to Twelve Wells	\$1,000.00
More than 12 Wells	\$1,500.00

The performance bond will be returned no sooner than one year after restoration has been accepted by the Department of Public works.

6. A permit fee of \$50.00 per each well.
