



Effective immediately, the Director of Public Works, in accordance with the authority granted in Section 54-416(3) of the City Code, establishes the following criteria for the waiving of the 300 foot spacing requirement in s. 54-420(e), as follows:

This regulation shall guide the Director of Public Works in exercising his/her discretion in waiving the 300 foot limitation between pay telephones on the same side of the street within the same block, on a sidewalk as provided in s. 54-420(e) of the Code of the City of Miami (or as that section may be renumbered or re-lettered by future amendments to the Code.

In order for an additional pay telephone location to be considered within 300 feet of any other pay telephone on the same side of the street or sidewalk there must be a demonstration that the public interest will be served by such additional installation due to geographic concerns, safety issues, or consumer need, evidenced by the report of an independent consultant provided by an applicant for such a pay telephone.

If the Director of Public Works finds such additional pay telephone installation to be warranted, he shall provide written notice of his findings and the basis for those findings to the closest existing Permittee within 300 feet of that location on the same block, which Permittee will then have ten (10) days in which to apply for a permit for the proposed additional pay telephone installation. Should the existing permittee choose not to apply for a permit for the proposed additional pay telephone location after written notification from the Director of Public Works, then such additional pay telephone location shall be made available for a permit application by any other qualified pay telephone provider.
