# **Quality Management Positions**

These are new procedures for the assignment of Quality Management positions and shall become effective upon signature of the parties. Openings shall be filled as specified below.

## Qualifications:

- > Captain's position
  - o Must be a Fire Captain
  - o Must be a State of Florida Certified Paramedic
- > Lieutenant's position
  - o Must be a Fire Lieutenant
  - Must be a State of Florida Certified Paramedic

## Selection process:

#### Captain's Position

- > Position(s) advertised for a minimum of 15 days
- > Bidders may submit a resume prior to the bid deadline
- > Selected by a committee consisting of three (3) Management representatives, three (3) Union representatives and the Medical Director or his/her designee.
- > The two individuals with the most votes shall make final selection. Final selection by majority vote.
- > In the event that the votes for the two (2) finalists are tied (selection committee members abstain from voting or are absent) then the finalist with the highest seniority in-grade shall be awarded the assignment.
- > If no Captains bid for the position the most junior swing or unassigned Paramedic Captain in the Emergency Response Division shall be assigned.

#### Lieutenant's Position

- > Position(s) advertised for a minimum of 15 days
- > Bidders may submit a resume prior to the bid deadline
- > Selected by a committee consisting of three (3) Management representatives, three (3) Union representatives and the Medical Director or his/her designee
- > In the event that the votes for the two (2) finalists are tied (selection committee members abstain from voting or are absent) then the finalist with the highest seniority in-grade shall be awarded the assignment.
- > If no Lieutenants bid for the position the most junior swing or unassigned Paramedic Lieutenant in the Emergency Response Division shall be assigned.
