FIRE INSPECTOR ELIGIBILITY  
FOR OFF DUTY WORK POLICY

POLICY


It is the policy of the Department of Fire, Rescue and Inspection Services to provide qualified Fire Inspectors for off-duty events or firewatch duty as determined by the Fire Marshal.

PROCEDURE

To determine "qualified", the following criteria shall be met to allow a Fire Inspector assigned to the FPB to be eligible for off-duty work or firewatch assignments:

1. Individual shall:
  - a. be a State Certified Fire Inspector, or
  - b. be eligible to sit for the State Exam, or
  - c. have previously been certified as a State Fire Inspector whose certification has lapsed, and is currently attending required schooling for recertification.
2. Individual shall be assigned as a District Fire Inspector or have been a District Fire Inspector in the past, or be eligible to be assigned as a District Fire Inspector by the Fire Marshal.
3. Individual shall have successfully completed off-duty events training to include fireworks training for events involving fireworks where individual shall be the sole Fire Inspector.
4. In an emergency or because of late notification of the FPB by a vendor or event coordinator and no qualified inspector is available or can be contacted, the Fire Marshal reserves the right to assign the most qualified individual available.

## **Fire Inspector Eligibility for Off-Duty Work Policy**

It is the policy of the Department of Fire, Rescue and Inspection Services to provide qualified Fire Inspectors for off-duty events or firewatch duty as determined by the Fire Marshal.

### **Procedure**

To determine "qualified", the following criteria shall be met to allow a Fire Inspector assigned to the FPB to be eligible for off-duty work or firewatch assignments:

1. Individual shall be either a State Certified Fire Inspector or eligible to sit to the State Exam.
2. Individual shall be assigned as a District Fire Inspector or have been a District Fire Inspector in the past, or be eligible to be assigned as a District Fire Inspector by the Fire Marshal.
3. Individual shall have successfully completed off-duty events training to include fireworks training for events involving fireworks where individual shall be the sole Fire Inspector.
4. In an emergency or because of late notification of the FPB by a vendor or event coordinator and no qualified inspector is available or can be contacted, the Fire Marshall reserves the right to assign the most qualified individual available.
