ON CALL ASSIGNMENT POLICY

The following procedures are to be utilized in the assignment of twenty four (24) hour on-call positions. Those members assigned to on-call positions shall receive 10% on-call pay.

- 1) Only those positions specifically designated and mutually agreed to by the Fire Chief and Local 587 will be covered.
- 2) Any increase or decrease in the number of on-call positions must be mutually agreed to by Local 587 and the Fire Chief.
- 3) If a member vacates a position, the person filling that position will receive the same benefit unless a change is mutually agreed to by Local 587 and the Fire Chief.
- 4) The present designated positions are as follows:
 - a) Four (4) Arson Investigators.
 - b) Communications Technical Coordinator.
 - c) Facilities Coordinator.
 - d) Hazardous Material Inspector.
 - e) Public Information Officer.
 - f) Special Events Officer
- 5) Those assigned to these on-call positions shall:
 - a) Be available for call via telephone or pager during all off-duty hours.
 - b) Respond in a timely fashion within a maximum of 30 minutes of being notified.

ON CALL ASSIGNMENT POLICY (Con'd.)

- c) When arriving at the scene of emergencies, report to the Officer-in-charge (command) and make him/her aware that you are physically on the scene.
- d) Be responsible to respond when requested during all offduty hours.
- 6) Each Division may develop operational procedures utilizing the above guidelines.
