Also, please furnish to us the names of the Chief Fire Officers who last occupied each of the positions which we were told were vacant at the time the matter was settled.

Any promotions to fill the vacancles listed above made from the Chief Fire Officer register which will be created on or about April 7, 1990, and from the Captain register which will be created on or about March 30, 1990, will be made retroactive to February 23, 1989, or the actual date of vacancy if it is later than February 23, 1989.
- 3. Those promotions from the Captain and/or Lieutenant registers which may be made as a result of the promotions referred to in paragraph 2 above will be made retroactive to the same dates as stated in paragraph 2.
- 4. This agreement is binding on the parties only in settlement of Grievance #9-89 and shall not be used as precedent or for any other purpose in arbitration, litigation or any other adversarial proceeding.
- 5. It is understood that it remains the City's position that promotions cannot be made and have not been made when there is no eligible register in existence. The Union does not agree with the City's position. This settlement agreement does not indicate a walver or change of the position of either the City or the Union.
